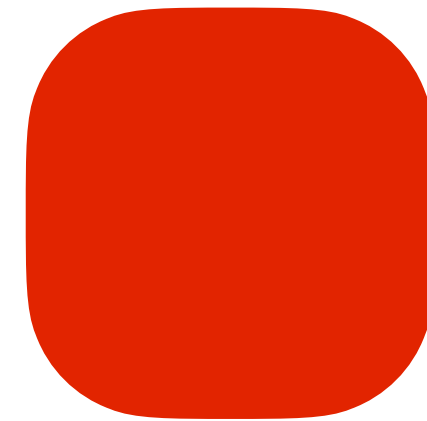
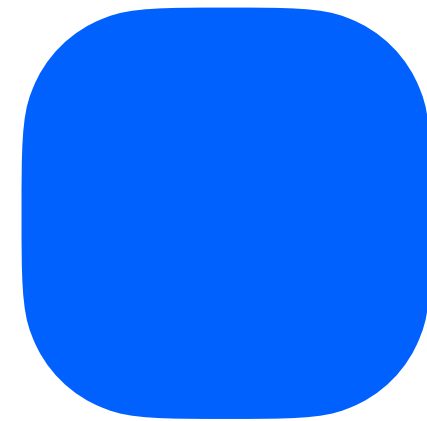

Interaction

- Introduce material before starting
- Have a warm up routine
- Encourage participation
- Incorporate activities
- Initiate detailed discussions

Collaboration

- Use icebreakers
- Foster an inclusive environment
- Encourage active listening
- Provide feedback opportunities
- Emphasise importance of practice

Personalisation

- Plan delivery around interests
- Take note of the student's goals
- Pace lessons to match ability
- Remember the student's goals
- Assess and match student' character

Features

- Use screen sharing regularly
- Use annotations and notes
- Use polls and quizzes
- Use the board with students
- Use hand raising

Participation

- Encourage student-led activities
- Encourage peer-to-peer interaction
- Create a supportive learning environment
- Offer incentives for active participation
- Encourage reflection and self-evaluation

Encouragement

- Give specific feedback
- Use positive language
- Recognise effort
- Offer praise where due
- Encourage goal-setting

Goals

- Help students focus on progress
- Assess the student's ability and level
- Regularly assess progress
- Provide guidance and support
- Celebrate milestones

Relatability

- Show practical applications
- Give culturally relevant examples
- Use novel examples
- Encourage critical thinking
- Encourage creative input

Flexibility

- Add some creativity and spontaneity
- Encourage full self-expression
- Periodically assess performance
- Try new tools and methods
- Ask for student feedback

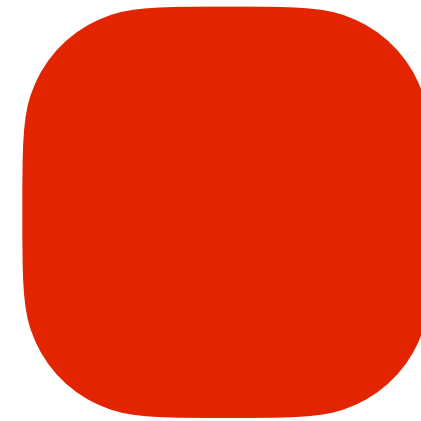
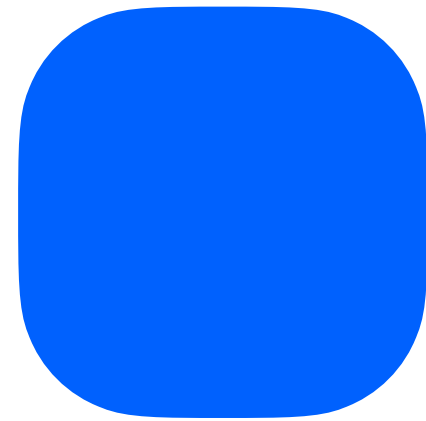
